Conditions Governing the Importation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances

These conditions are issued subject to the provisions of the Environmental Management Act No. 12 of 2011, the general provisions of Part V of the Environmental Management (Licensing) Regulations, Statutory Instrument No. 112 of 2013 and the following specific conditions:

- a) These conditions shall be valid for the **Importation of: Sulphuric acid 96%** (Sulphur) a product of **Interchem, 562 15 Road, Randjespark Midrand South Africa.**

- b) **Sulphuric acid 96%** shall be valid for the following use only: as a selective Herbicide against gramineous weeds.
- c) **InterChem** shall ensure that the **Sulphuric acid 96%** imported into Zambia bears a label which is approved by the Zambia Environmental Management Agency (ZEMA).
- d) **InterChem** shall ensure that the **labelling** requirements of the **Sulphuric acid 96%** shall be as set out in the Eleventh Schedule of the Environmental Management (Licensing) Regulations, Statutory Instrument No. 112 of 2013.
- e) The **Sulphuric acid 96%** shall be packed in a container or package that-
- does not react chemically or physically with **Sulphuric Acid 96%**; and
 - is capable of preventing the leakage or spillage of **Sulphuric acid 96%** during handling and transportation.
- f) **InterChem** shall notify ZEMA at least ninety (90) days before the arrival of the **Sulphuric acid 96%** as set out in Form XIII of the First Schedule.

- g) **InterChem** shall use a transporter with a valid Pesticides and Toxic Substances Licence for transportation of **Sulphuric Acid**.
- h) **InterChem** shall send **bi-annual reports** related to the Importation of Pesticides and Toxic Substances to ZEMA without fail **on or before July 15 and January 15** for each year of the validity period for the licence in the attached format. In addition, electronic copies of the Reports shall be sent to returns@zema.org.zm.
- i) The licence is valid for a period of three years from the **16th day of September, 2025** to **15th day of September, 2028** and may be renewed for a like period if **InterChem** complies with these conditions.
- j) **InterChem** shall not transfer the licence to a third party without the prior approval by ZEMA.
- k) An application for **renewal and/or transfer** shall be made at least six months before the expiry of the licence.
- l) ZEMA may **revoke and/or suspend** this licence at any time and **without notice** in the event that **InterChem** fails to comply with these conditions.
